


This competition will be an opportunity to show once again the beauty of this sport which brings athletes together from all over Latin America, and connects countries both off ice and on the ice.

TRANSPORTATION

ARRIVALS

WEATHER

In November, Quito experiences pleasant temperatures, The average temperature in Quito during November is around 14.4°C (58°F). The minimum temperature typically hovers around 9.5°C (49.2°F), while the maximum reaches approximately 19.4°C (66.9°F). On the coldest nights, the temperature may drop to around 5.5°C (42°F), while on the warmest days, it can reach about 22.5°C (72°F).

ELECTRICITY

The voltage in Ecuador is 110 V, 60 Hz.

CURRENCY AND EXCHANGE

The currency in Ecuador is the US Dollar, foreign currency can be exchanged in official exchange offices.

Most of the Banks have cash machines ATM, which operate 24 hours a day.
